Discussions:

1. Volunteer update -

- a. *Saturday, March 25 is Garden Day; 9.00-12.00 for toddlers and EC; 9.00-1.00 for Elementary school. Ms Angela will plant later in the week if student is not there on Saturday. Toddlers and EC children can create Peace messages on rocks on Saturday too. Patricia Albernoz will work in the peace garden. Elementary will do it another day next week. Info will go out again in Friday Newsblast.*
- b. April 7 is international picnic at 5.00-7.00 pm. It will be outside and in the multipurpose room. Norma is in charge of Mexico's group/booth. She will follow up with the event committee volunteers. She will ask some parents to help out with children's outdoor activities. Norma has also printed a big picnic flyer for the school door and Melissa Taylor and Hana Im have volunteered to make creative continent signs. Grace has asked Theresa to add the info in the school homepage. She will also inform room parents and teachers. Two parents from the Events group will help organize the picnic. People will sit outside under the roof to eat. 8 tables will be rented for this purpose. School will provide water and crystal light. We need parents to bring ice and drinks as well. We are asking each table to bring food from the country they are presenting for people to taste. For inside we can use the big tables and rent tables. Set up tables in

a U-shape, by continent. The activity booths will be placed in the middle of this U-shape. Alumni are invited and we are expecting about 80 families. Families may begin setting up their country booths at 4.00 pm on the day of the event. Blanca and staff will begin table and chair set up at 1.00 pm. We have leftover flags and a banner that we'll use to decorate with.

Hanna and Grace will hand out passports to the kids and they will use them when they visits the booths to collect stamps. Ideas for activities: musical chairs, "Mexican lotteria," 1 activity per booth inside. The school will run a "creation station" and provide supplies for indoor activities: play dough, flag books to draw country flags, decorate your own bag fro country trinkets, colors and construction paper. Dips will bring bubble wands for outside activity and she will show how to do an indian dance with the kids; also for outside hula hoops and bean bag toss.
